Our Academy

Franklin Virtual Academy (FVA):

- provides self-paced online courses that are rigorous, interactive, multi-media rich, and aligned with national and PA Standards;
- customizes educational paths to challenge students and meet their individual needs;

Anytime & Anywhere



Students have access to their online courses wherever Internet access is available and whenever they are ready to learn. They might choose to work from home, while traveling, or even bedside.

Elementary-level courses are designed to be completed within a standard nine-month school year— no summer school required. Students are given eighteen weeks to complete courses at the secondary level. It is permissible for students to complete their work early, if they choose to do so.

Blending Courses



Concerned about your child being too isolated while taking online courses?

FVA gives your child the opportunity to reap the benefits of the social interaction that comes with attending in-school courses while enjoying the flexibility of online learning.
